Program Overview

TEAM PLACEMENT

When forming teams, we consider factors such as athlete skills, experience, maturity, performance, and team needs. Team placement is primarily determined by birth year and skill level. Athletes that try out are typically selected for a team and will be evaluated on their technique and consistency. Rosters, placement within routines, and participation, are subject to change at any point and for any reason under coaches' discretion. Team announcements will be sent to the email on file on June 8.

COMPETITION SCHEDULE

The competition schedule varies by team. Most teams will attend competitions hosted both locally and nationally, with the opportunity to be invited to and to attend End-Of-Season Events (i.e., The Regional Summit, The Cheerleading Worlds, The Summit). Competition schedules will be released after team placements.

SEASON TRAVEL

Season travel varies by team. Most teams will attend 1-2 competitions per season that require out-of-town travel. Travel expenses are not included in tuition. Athletes are required to book travel in accordance with guidelines provided throughout the season. Travel dates will be shared after the competition schedule is released.

PRACTICE AND ATTENDANCE

Participating in our All Star Cheer program is a 12-month commitment. During June, July, and August, teams will practice twice per week on . Starting September 8, all Junior/Senior/Worlds elite teams will practice a third day each week on Sundays.

All athletes must register for and attend a Regular Evaluation Session. During the evaluation, athletes will perform a Mini Routine. Mini Routine videos will be posted on Instagram the week of May 6. Athletes will be given a callback time at the end of their Regular Evaluation Session that indicates which callback session they should attend on June 2. Athletes wanting to be considered for a flyer position should register for and attend Flyer Tryouts in addition to the Regular Evaluation Session. Attending Flyer Tryouts does not guarantee a flyer spot on a team. If an athlete is unable to attend any of the Regular Evaluation Sessions, we offer Late Tryout Sessions on June 3 & 4. Late Tryout Sessions only include Mini Routine and tumbling skills.

Financial Commitment

Participating in All Star Cheer requires a significant financial commitment. It's important to carefully consider the investment involved. Tuition is divided into monthly installments and is due on the first of each month. Billing begins in June 2024 and continues through April 2025. Tuition remains consistent from month to month and is payable online through our customer portal. Members are required to keep a valid credit or debit card on file. Tuition covers team training, regular season competition fees, and other non-refundable expenses. We offer a sibling discount for each additional athlete per family.

Additional costs include but are not limited to; our annual membership fee (due June 10), a one-time choreography and music Fee (due July 15), End-Of-Season Events, required apparel items that athletes keep, travel expenses, and the USASF Athlete Membership fee (due July 5). Adult Athletes (members that turn 18 years old prior to 6/1/24) are responsible for their Background Check Screening, paid during membership registration in June and required for eligibility.
