











TEAM PLACEMENT

Team placement is primarily determined by birth year and skill level. Athletes that try out are typically selected for a team. Rosters, placement within routines, and participation, are subject to change at any point and for any reason under coaches' discretion. Team placements will be sent via email on Friday, May 31, at 6:00 PM.

COMPETITION SCHEDULE

The competition schedule varies by team. Novice teams compete at local events only. Elite teams attend competitions hosted both locally and nationally, as well as have the opportunity to be invited to End-of-Season Events (i.e., The Summit, The Cheerleading Worlds) and Champions League. Competition schedules will be released after team placements. Travel expenses are not included in tuition. Athletes are required to book travel in accordance with any guidelines provided throughout the season.

PRACTICE AND ATTENDANCE

Participating in our All Star Cheer program is a 12 month commitment. Teams practice twice weekly. Additional practices and extended practices will be scheduled during important times of the season. Athletes are expected to prioritize their participation in our program and fully commit to attending all scheduled practices.

FINANCIAL COMMITMENT

Participating in All Star Cheer requires a significant financial commitment. It's important to carefully consider the investment involved. Tuition is divided into 12 monthly installments and is due on the first of each month. Billing begins June 1, 2024 and continues through April 15, 2025. Tuition remains consistent from month to month and is payable online through our customer portal. Members are required to keep a card on file. Tuition covers team training and other non-refundable expenses.

Additional costs include but are not limited to; our annual membership, a one-time choreography and music fee, End-of-Season Event fees, extra competition fees, required apparel items that athletes keep, travel expenses, and the USASF Athlete Membership fee. Adult Athletes (members that turn 18 years old prior to 6/1/24) are responsible for their Background Check Screening, paid during membership registration in June and required for eligibility. Cost varies by country. The choreography and music fee is non-refundable and due on July 15, 2024. Required apparel items are purchased after team placements. Uniform pricing varies by team.
